


Gen. Dwight

- Led successful invasions in North Africa & Italy
- Named Supreme Commander of all Allied forces in Europe
- Planned and led the Allied invasion of France (Operation Overlord/D-Day)



General Reorge S. Patton



 Led Operation Torch and the invasion of North Africa

Commanded the US
 Third Army after the
 Normandy invasion

 Inspired his tired troops to victories across
 France and into Nazi
 Germany



- Gen. Douglas MacArthur
 - Supreme Commander of US forces in the Pacific
 - Forced to flee the Philippines after Japan attacked
 - Led US forces through New Guinea and back to the Philippines
 - Accepted and signed Japan's official surrender in September 1945

Winston Chu

- Warned about Nazi Germany prior to WWII
- Became England's Prime Minister after Neville Chamberlain's resignation in 1940
- Refused any armistice with Nazi Germany
- His speeches and broadcasts inspired the British people





Montgomery

- Commanded the British Eighth Army
- Led forces through North
 Africa and important victory
 at El Alamein
- Led the Allied invasions of Sicily and Italy
- Was in command of Allied ground forces for D-Day

Charles de Gaulle



- Commanded French
 armored division against
 Nazi Germany
- Refused to accept
 France's surrender & led
 the Free French
 government in exile
- Commanded the French resistance from England and North Africa
